



Technology SA SUBMISSION/ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

This area of ITEEA's Online Publication Library contains refereed graduate student manuscripts. Any student enrolled in a university graduate program designed to prepare K-12 teachers of technology, innovation, design, and engineering (TIDE) education may submit research papers for this refereed/electronic publishing process. The student MUST be an ITEEA member and sole author(s). The following process and criteria will be used in consideration of the submitted research papers.

- Paper must be based on advancing thought and practice in technology, innovation, design, and/or engineering education.
- Student must be enrolled in an M.S., Ed.S., Ed.D., Ph.D., or recertification/licensure program of study that advances TIDE education at the time the paper is submitted.
- All authors must be graduate students at time of authorship.
- Manuscript must be reviewed and signed by the student's faculty advisor. The advisor cannot be a coauthor.
- Paper must be submitted in electronic form to: kdelapaz@iteea.org.

The referee process will center on the following criteria:

1. Importance/impact to the research-base for teaching TIDE education.
2. Contribution to philosophy/theory, research, or practice will be considered that is of meaningful interest and application to advancing TIDE education.
3. Paper must be written in a scholarly manner with sound research writing skills evident using APA citations.
4. Papers beyond 15 pages (including tables and references) will not be accepted.

Papers for consideration may be submitted to kdelapaz@iteea.org. Upon submission, papers will undergo independent review by faculty at member universities. Upon acceptance, papers will be included in ITEEA's online library.
